Colette:

Welcome to INSIDE THE WOONIVERSE, Woo², that's a little bit of woo x2. In these shorter episodes, you're going to hear more of me like audio journal, on universal topics like abundance, resilience, working with the moon and manifestation and meditation and much, much more.

Connie:

Okay, so now I'm going to open up the journal. Okay, this is my very first time, I heard rumblings of you writing this.

Colette:

Yes, you sure did.

Connie:

Earlier this year, right?

Colette:

Lots of rumblings.

Connie:

Lots of rumblings, and I love oracle cards, I love journaling, so together this is the baby of both. So here we go, for our ASMR friends who love to hear the crinkles, I'm opening up the package right now. And whoa, look at this thing. OMG.

Isn't it beautiful?

Connie:
First of all, it smells amazing. I just want to say that, fresh paper, fresh paper journal.

Colette:
I smell that smell too. I can't believe that you and I have never talked about that.

Connie:
Oh my gosh.

Colette:
As soon as September comes, I go into Staples to smell it.

Connie:
Yes. The paper, even the wax of the crayons, the pens, okay, it's all great. So this journal is absolutely beautiful, designed by-

Colette:
Hay House.

Connie:
Okay, not Brooke?

Colette:
No, I think Brooke and Hay House got together to do this together. But it was, I have to tell you, it's a real labor of love. This was my most favorite project besides actually channeling oracle cards, because I receive the content for each Oracle Card deck that I do. But this was a real labor of love for me because it was the first time I was able to put the two together for people to really understand that working with oracle cards on their own, solo, could be such a deep and meaningful and rich experience without them using the cards to kind of fortune tell, if you will, what's going to happen. Predictive. It's not about that. It's being able to see yourself, to know



yourself, to really find parts of you that you might have lost along the way of your journey, and the cards can help you. It's just so incredible when you start to realize that your pen and the deck can-

Together.

Colette:
... give you, yes, such an access to spirit too. It really is a spiritual awakening. This whole thing here is designed for that.

Connie:
This is amazing. It's called the Oracle Card Journal: A Daily Practice for Igniting Your Insight, Intuition and Magic. What you just said sounds like all of the above. So let's open it up. This is the first time I'm ever seeing it. This is beautiful.

Colette:
It's gorgeous. I'm really happy.

Connie:
Oh, this is so nice. It is so nice. Okay, so what's amazing about this book is that it looks like you have a card a day where you can write the info on one side and draw what the card means to you. But then you have what is being revealed today for my highest good, which is amazing. So could you maybe talk to us a little bit about, first of all, can you use any deck with this?

Colette:
Yes, you absolutely can. You can use anybody's deck. The best decks that work with this process are decks that are true divination systems. And I don't know what those are necessarily. I have suggestions of other people's decks besides my own in the back of the book, resources, recommended decks, etc. These are all decks that I've actually held in my hand. But I have to say that you would feel that connection. And then the gist of this is to do this for 40 days solid because that's when you start to see the real evidence, that you are not only connected to you,



like yourself, yourself and your journey, but you are plugged in to this higher self that reveals itself to you on the pages without you knowing it's coming.

That's kind of the best way I could describe this, that there's an higher self that all of us have that we don't always have access to because we get so caught in human issues. All the things that are going on day to day, which we don't realize, our soul, our higher self, that connection to spirit that is immortal that knows why we're here, that knows our deepest longing and yearning, that we don't spend enough time with, that comes through every time. And it's perfect for people who love to journal and now it's added something else, but it's also perfect for people who have a hard time journaling because it gives you a subject.

Connie:

Yes, and you have all these beautiful prompts. So just to pick up on what you just said, so it's like this is a 40 day invitation, initiation, to getting more insight into your relationship with Spirit and with your higher self. Now, do you recommend that a person uses the same deck for all 40 days to really strengthen that?

Colette:

You know what's interesting, that's something that never even occurred to me because I do use multiple decks.

Connie:

Yeah, me too.

Colette:

So if somebody has multiple decks and they're already an aficionado, if you will, they love Oracle cards or whatever, I say you can swap out your decks, why not, according to how you feel that day. But if you're relatively new and you haven't really developed a relationship to a particular deck, now this is oracle cards this isn't tarot, this is definitely specifically for oracle cards, and you're just new to one particular system, which is the deck because each deck is its own little universe. It's different than the tarot, which is a system that's always going to be reliable and



always going to be there, it's a fixed system, and this is more fluid. So you want to work with the same deck.

Connie:

Okay, yep.

Colette:

So if you're new. So I personally, me personally, I would mix it up.

Connie:

Yes. Well, like you said, if you're called to a different deck every day, go for it.

Colette:

Yeah, there's no real hard or fast rules. It's like what do I feel drawn to today? Sometimes I'll take Rebecca's cards, Rebecca Campbell's, sometimes I'll pull from, I don't know, what can I tell you? I mean, I have 14 decks, so I will switch out my own decks. I mean I'm obviously most comfortable with my decks because I know my decks will be reliable in terms of the fact that they were created, they were inspired by ancient divination practices so I already know that the lexicon is going to work or the vocabulary will work and reflect back to me what is true. So that's why I feel my card decks are reliable. But there are lots of people who make great card decks, so you have to know which one you're drawn to, or ones, again multiple ones, and pick those. You don't have to just use mine.

Connie:

Yeah, and if you even don't have a deck, I just want to give a little plug to your digital cards, because you have a few different digital decks online at colettebaronreid.com.

Colette:

That you can do for free, exactly. So you can go to my website colettebaronreid.com and go and check them out for free and then you can also buy a deck. And if you want digital deck you can also go to Beauty Everywhere, which is an app online, and they have quite a few of my decks that you can purchase for use on your phone. Or, you have the hard copy decks which is really



what I suggest. I always say the digital deck is your secondary deck for your purse. I always have two versions of my decks or the decks that I like and I have a hard copy at home, and I'm not going to lug them all around in my purse, and then I have my phone which is the Beauty Everywhere app. Now that Hay House no longer does apps all my decks are pretty much on the Beauty Everywhere app.

Connie:

I have another question about this journal. So I love when you get science-y. You know I love when you get science-y.

Colette:

Yes, yes.

Connie:

So you mentioned oracular consciousness in the journal.

Colette:

I did.

Connie:

Can you please share with us oracular consciousness, the definition and how oracle cards work with that consciousness?

Colette:

Oh wow, okay. So let's just riff on that because it is one of my favorite subjects. So oracular consciousness indicates that we have inherently within us the capacity to receive an oracle or wise guidance from the world around us, from a card deck or from whatever system of divination that we have in front of us, to understand it and to immediately apply it through the mechanism of synchronicity. So oracular consciousness reminds us that we are spiritual beings having a human experience and that we are intuitive beings. So intuitive intelligence and oracular consciousness are kind of cousins. When you think about that, the kind of consciousness that we're talking about tunes into the peripheral world and the hidden world.



The world that is not measurable by the five senses, that you can't necessarily see with your naked eye but that is all around us and is always giving us information.

So it's this sense that we have, this really sensitive radar, if you will, that every one of us is equipped with. So oracular consciousness is like psychic radar. We just have not been taught how to turn it on. Many of us have, obviously, that's why it's so popular now because people are starting to recognize that every single human being on the planet, hello, has this. But it's a specific type of consciousness that can really help us because oracular consciousness also is connected to the desire for the universe to always be in harmony. So we know that, if you look at the metronome experiment for example, and when you see those metronomes and they go out of sync... there's a video on the internet, it's very famous, right... and you make one go this way and the rest of them are going this way, and all of a sudden they start to get coherent with each other in sync.

There's a sync that happens. So the universe is always alive. It is in itself as conscious and it is always seeking harmony. So when it's out of harmony, when it's disharmonious, when it's all over the place, the reason why chaos happens is because the things that don't work, that need to go, get replaced by something else, and there's that disharmony in the center of it or they're trying to get rid of the disharmonies to bring things back into harmony. So the consciousness that I'm talking about always tunes into that. The layman's term is the highest good of all. So what is the highest good of all, which isn't necessarily the highest good of the ego want. It's the need of us being a part of a system, a grand system of millions of people that are here on behalf of the conscious universe because we're made by it, and so we're used by it. If we allow ourselves to be used in such a way for the highest good, miracles can and do happen. So, that's how oracle cards work.

Connie:

Okay, I was just going to say, so oracle cards are also part of that symphony of tools like us and cards together.



Colette:

So the cards are a tool that serves to give structure to the language and vocabulary of oracular consciousness, of the potentials. And so my card decks, and many others, I mean, we're introducing people on Inside the Wooniverse, which is super exciting, because there's a lot of people now that are delving into this that are going back in time and looking at some of our ancestral divination tools, et cetera. For me, I went way back when. What does this mean? How did they do that? And then, what could it mean now? So what does every divination tool have in common or intuitive tool have in common is they work off a system and they work off a vocabulary. I always like to think of oracle cards as a dialect of the tarot. So the tarot is a very fixed system of 78 cards that are always going to have the same symbols, etc. It's reliable. It's why you have these big tarot communities. Whereas oracles are like different dialects, different versions of the more fixed systems.

Connie:

Interpretations, yeah.

Colette:

Exactly.

Connie:

I love that. Oh my God, that's so beautiful, so accurate.

Colette:

They're innovative. Right? It's true. It's like they're innovated. And so I create oracle cards, I love the tarot no question, I mean I've used it and taught it for years, but I got really interested in oracles. I got very interested in oracles and creating them because of the fluidity of them and you could actually create a different type of vocabulary that potentially could still speak to the archetypal universal experience of all human beings because we're just human, but also to reflect what could happen or we could experience as we evolve in the modern world as modern people.



Connie:

And the nuances of all those things, because it's a thing plus all the variations of that thing, right?

Colette:

Right, it's nuanced.

Connie:

Absolutely. That's amazing. And with the journal it's like you are able to make all these connections and with the act of writing really be able to kind of absorb. Is that also the idea of when you're writing it down that it makes further connections?

Colette:

What's really cool, and again I'm using the terminology oracular consciousness, that you can lose yourself in writing. So that's the thing. That's why I really want people to use this oracle card journal and use anybody's deck. If you find a brand new deck creator that's never done it before but you think their deck is so fantastic, go for it. If you find a teacher that you think is really cool and you love what they stand for and you like their deck, go for that. Or go for mine, because I can tell you about mine. But the point is, this was created so that anybody's oracle deck could work with it because the point of it is for you to allow the card, whatever card that you pick, to awaken the oracular consciousness within you and then you move yourself out of the way as you just let your pen go.

And it's so cool because all of a sudden you get out of your mental construct of analysis of this is me writing this down about my life, and into all of a sudden it's like, oh wow, you end up almost channeling. And I could say actually that is the correct word for channeling. It's not that you're channeling some entity like my friend, he has the Z's, he's got a great book out.

Connie:

Lee Harris.



Colette:

Lee Harris, exactly, who I adore. It's not channeling energies or entities. It's really channeling your higher self, that is the seat of oracular consciousness, is the higher self that does not define itself by your mortality. And everybody has it.

Connie:

Beautiful.

Colette:

It's a way for you to bypass your conditioning, and I will use that term, that's a very popular term these days. We're not spiritually bypassing anything, what you're doing is bypassing your conditioning that actually prevent you from tuning into that extraordinary consciousness that you have access to. You just have to turn it on. This is a way for you to turn it on and exercise it and the cards are the door openers. They're like the keys to open a door. The subject comes up and then all of a sudden-

Connie:

Enter.

Colette:

You enter a different dimension, you really do. You enter a different dimension of consciousness and all of a sudden information comes to you, things that you don't even know you know. This is what I know happens to people when they use this.

Connie:

Absolutely. And connections that you didn't even consider all of a sudden are like how could I have never considered this exact connection or this pattern or this fill in the blank. Right?

Colette:

Well, this is a way for people to also midwife their own epiphanies. It's a give birth to your own epiphanies. I always say too that in oracle school, the school that I have which is all about personal transformation, we use oracle cards as the main tool to navigate that. Use any deck



because this is going to work with any deck. And the ones that it works best with are the ones that you know are created to be a divination system. So that's the other thing, because why? Because that means that person's intention was you to look at this as a system of conversation between you and the divine as opposed to a thought for the day. It's different.

Connie:

That's right. And you even list, like you said, you have an index in the back where you've given some recommendations and you have some of our Inside the Wooniverse friends like Chris Anne and Crystal Banner listed as well and Kyle Gray. So one more question for you.

Colette:

Sure.

Connie:

I have another question. Your journal is, the container is a 40 day practice.

Colette:

Right.

Connie:

So do you have any guidance for someone, is there any preparation? I know people, like you said, they will or won't or they don't have to, but what would you say to someone who really wants to squeak the most out of this experience and really gain the most? How could they prepare?

Colette:

Don't overanalyze it.

Connie:

Okay.



Colette:

Just go with it and see where it leads you. It's like be curious. I think the best advice I could give anybody, and this is kind of what I think is our superpower anyway, oracular consciousness is opened through curiosity and through recognizing that your imagination is in service to your soul. Your intuition is in service to your soul, and therefore it is in service to all of humanity. That's kind of a big statement that I just said, but just be curious and see what comes up. The inscription at the top of the temple at Delphi says know thy self. That was the most famous place, a sacred site in ancient Greece where we get a lot of our oracles from, and the Oracle at Delphi, that was an institution in Greece and people would come to visit the Oracle at Delphi. And it didn't say come and get your future told, it said know thy self.

And that means that within that, we are powerful co-creative beings, and all of us, regardless of our conditioning, have the capacity within us to give birth to miracles. I really believe that. And we can do what is best for everybody where no matter where we sit, even though we may have contributed to pain, suffering, who the hell knows? You know what I mean? It's like we all have a part to play in the big giant play of life. But what this enables us to do is get back to the core of who we really are, and that's what all oracles are for, wise guidance that are reflected both by you, your higher self, but also in communication with a conscious universe that has something to say if we're willing to listen.

Our conditioning is what has prevented us from really genuinely hearing it. We typically listen through a lens or a filter that was provided to us by the people who came before, by our society, by the constructs that we don't even agree with. If we were to really sit down and go, "Okay, this is what I've been taught." We're like, "Oh," because that's happening right now, we're questioning how we've been conditioned.

Connie:

It's so interesting, as you're talking the analogy that comes to mind is we were all, once upon a time, only able to listen to radio stations and so we had to hear what their playlists were and people, not us, decided what we listened to and what was good and the top 10 and this and that. Then all of a sudden with all the streaming opportunities and of course independent records, but also streaming opportunities, we can now make our own playlists. And so it's like cultivating a



playlist, cultivating what do I really love that is beyond the top 10 or whatever. And to the point that you gave-

Colette:

I love this.

Connie:

... the Oracle cards are like a playlist, right? This is like you getting to know thy self. And when you know yourself you know other people because things are reflected back in lessons. If you make decisions and intentions out of the highest good of all, it is the ultimate said it and forget it because it means everyone's taken care of, everybody's considered. And it may not/likely not be exactly what you want but it will be what everybody needs.

Colette:

No, sometimes it's not at all.

Connie:

Exactly. It'll be what everybody needs. And how great is that, that everyone gets something and that really is very abundant. I love how you always say that oracle cards are the new self-care.

Colette:

Yes.

Connie:

What does that mean to you and how do you feel this journal is in companion to that concept of self-care?

Colette:

I love that you asked me that question and eventually it won't be the new self-care, it'll just be part of it. But I think that working with oracle cards as part of your self-care program enables you to have a greater understanding of yourself and what you're dealing with, but also to love yourself more and to not see yourself ever as broken.



That's the other thing. I know that it's really buzzy right now to talk about trauma and to talk about healing and wellness and all these things, yes, all those things are true, but I also know that every one of us, we have wholeness already inherent in us. It's like I believe that we were born blessed. That the original blessing, the teachings of Matthew Fox, all of these kind of teachers that say don't look for what is broken, look to choose the healed part, as opposed to staring constantly at what's going wrong.

Working with oracle cards I think gives you a quick and very intimate relationship between you and your higher power, and that's also, I think, if you can have that intimate relationship with your higher power and if oracle cards are the way in which you can navigate that and can actually facilitate that, you're already on that wellness self-care because the self that gets lost is not the ego self, it's the soul. We're trying to retrieve a part of ourselves that's just got ignored. And the soul self knows that we live with the earth, we are part of it not on top of it. There is a wisdom and oracular consciousness is a wisdom that all of us have, and when we tap into that wisdom we stop doing the things that cause us harm and cause other people harm. It's a big statement that I'm making right now, but these are just some of the thoughts that I have if we could make this a habit.

Absolutely.
